The lecture focuses on the history of tile making industries in the Southern Netherlands. Alongside some historical and technical information some case studies will be discussed. The restoration of in-situ tiles presents us with some difficulties, during a workshop a new method for filling in gaps will be presented. This method was developed to pursue a long lasting treatment, which is resistant to changing climatic conditions.

Bauvois Stefanie teaches ceramics conservation at the faculty of Design Science, University of Antwerp. As a practice assistant she guides students through restoration treatments, which are conducted on objects from Antwerp museums. Furthermore she teaches all aspect of ceramics technology, degradation and conservation alongside with preventive care for collections. In addition she's active on the field of restoration of art in public spaces, mainly in the Netherlands.
